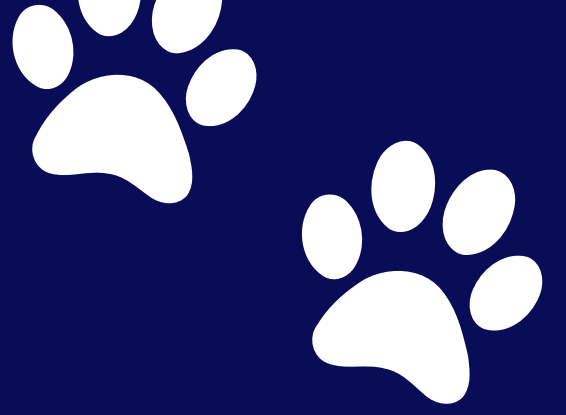


These things can help:

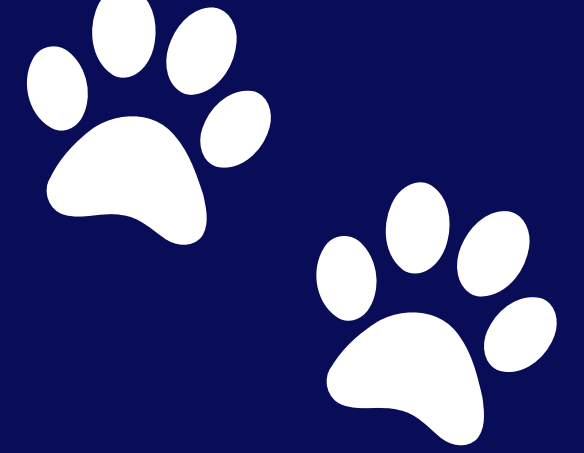

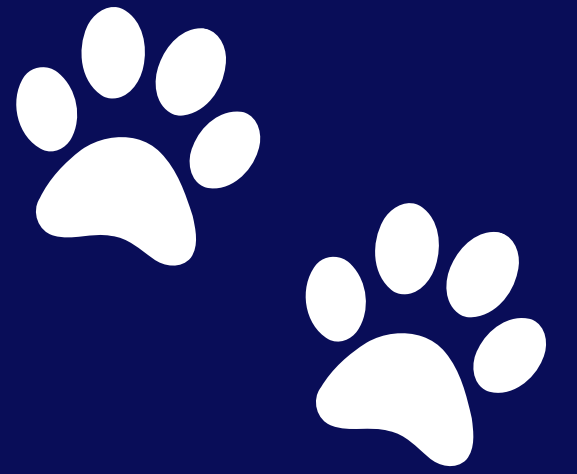


These things can help:
