

Year Six -we would like the children to complete some of the following every day.

Reading	The children need to read at least twenty minutes each day. They can find the meanings of unfamiliar words, then find synonyms and put them into sentences. There is a pack to help answer the more trick three-mark questions on a SAT's paper.
Maths	I have included areas we are currently working on as well as a selection of arithmetic papers - the answers are included. The following website is really useful: https://www.mathsisfun.com/ Just type in an area -such as long division.
Literacy	There are a number of revision Power Points. There is also a SPAG test.
Topic	Our current topic is the Vikings. I would like the children to carry out their own research about Viking life in Britain.
