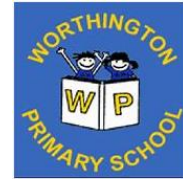

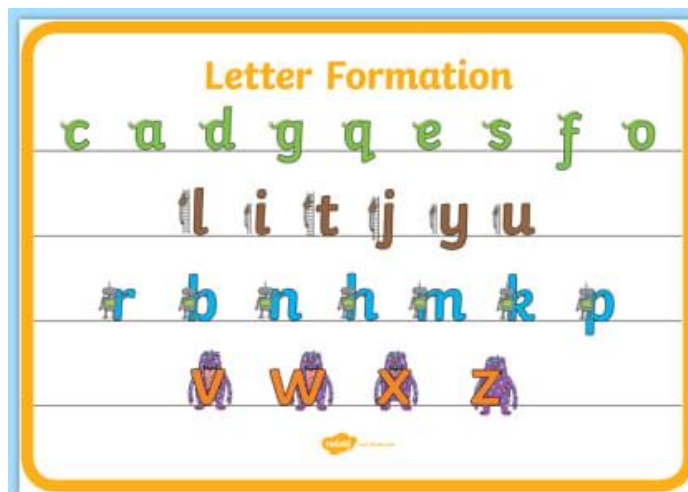

<p>Maths</p> <p><i>Choose one from each section</i></p>	<p>Warm up:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play a maths game on Education City - use the logon given out at parents evening or in your folder • Play a game on espresso - <i>once logged in click on Key Stage One Maths and choose an area of maths</i> • Complete a maths mat from <i>the maths mats</i> <p>Main Activity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activity from the <i>addition and subtraction booklet (in folder sent home)</i> • Activity from the <i>Spring maths booklet (in folder sent home)</i> • Activity from the <i>White Rose Maths folder</i> <p>Problem Solving and Reasoning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Choose a problem from the <i>classroom secrets folder</i> <p>Remember to use resources when needed: photocopied numicon, money etc</p>
<p>Literacy:</p> <p><i>Choose one from each section</i></p>	<p>Warm-up:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SPaG mat from the <i>SPaG mat folder</i> • Phonics mat from the <i>Phonic mat folder</i> <p>Main Activity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading comprehension (<i>reading comprehension folder</i>) • Sequencing an activity (<i>sequencing folder</i>) • Rewrite the activity you have sequenced in your book as a story/instructions/recount (don't forget to use the guidelines under the page) • Listen to a story on Espresso (<i>log in - click on Key Stage One - English -click on books</i>) • Complete the follow up activities -comprehension and sequence the story. • Rewrite the story in your book. Use the writing mats sent home at parents evening for reference. • Story Challenge: Invent your own story by changing aspects of one of the stories you have listened to.

	<p>Letters and Sounds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use <i>espresso</i> to watch a video of one of the phonemes/graphemes we have already learned so far this year click on Key Stage One – click on English – click on Phonics -click on the appropriate phase – the children will know which sounds they have covered • Play the games on <i>Espresso</i> related to the sounds or tricky words we have learned • Phonic Games on phonics play https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/ • Phonic games on https://classroomsecrets.co.uk/kids/ (free to log on as a parent at the moment - click on Year 1 to access phonic games) • Read the words already sent home at parents evening
