

Year Three -we would like the children to complete some of the following every day.

Handwriting	Attached are handwriting sheets focussing on the joins that the children have been learning in school. These could either be printed out and completed on the sheet, or copied onto plain paper.
Maths	<p>We have attached a selection of Place Value activities for the children to work through. We covered this topic back in the Autumn Term, so this can serve as a recap to ensure understanding.</p> <p>The learning objectives these cover are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Identify, estimate and represent numbers using different representations.• Find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number.• Recognise the place value of each digit in a three digit number (hundreds,tens,ones)• Compare and order numbers up to 1000• Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and words• Solve number problems and practical problems involving these• Count from 0 in multiples of 50 and 100.
Literacy	<p>We have attached activities for the children to recap the Spelling Punctuation and Grammar objectives that we have covered so far this year.</p> <p>These include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Using present perfect form of verbs• Using conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions• Improving basic sentences

Topic	<p>Our current topic is the Victorians. We have attached several activities for the children to complete based on this. These include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reading comprehension• Research project• Task sheet (choose from various activities)
